This Addendum No. 1 is issued to make the following changes and clarifications on IFB No. 2017-SP-07:

1. The Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority "CCRTA" has revised Section 9.0 Base Cost of the Special Terms and Conditions located on page 10 of 31 of the IFB as follows:

Current Section 9.0:

9.0 BASE COST

The base cost per gallon of fuel for purposes of deliveries in any week under this Contract will be equal to the lowest price available to the Contractor. The base cost per gallon will be subject to increase or decrease on a daily basis during the term of this supply agreement by the change in the Oil Price Information Service (OPIS) average pricing for the date of delivery to CCRTA operation facility located at 5658 Bear Lane Corpus Christi, Texas 78405 will be used for cost per gallon for duration of the contract. Prior to award of the Contract, the successful BIDDER must indicate in writing to the CCRTA which refineries it will use. The refineries selected will be maintained for the duration of the Contract unless prior approval is obtained from the CCRTA to add/delete refineries.

Revised Section 9.0:

9.0 BASE COST

The base cost per gallon for each fuel type shall be based on the average unbranded rack cost as detailed in the daily Oil Price Information (OPIS) report for that day's delivery. (Vendor shall supply with each invoice a copy of the corresponding OPIS for each delivery). The base cost per gallon will be subject to increase or decrease on a daily basis during the term of this supply agreement by the change in the Oil Price Information Service (OPIS) average pricing for the date of delivery to CCRTA operation facility located at 5658 Bear Lane Corpus Christi, Texas 78405 will be used for cost per gallon for duration of the contract. Prior to award of the Contract, the successful BIDDER must indicate in writing to the CCRTA which refineries it will use. The refineries selected will be maintained for the duration of the Contract unless prior approval is obtained from the CCRTA to add/delete refineries.
