Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority Service Levels After Hurricane Harvey

CORPUS CHRISTI, Texas – Due to the recent storm and the current safety restrictions on the roads, the Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority (CCRTA) will have limited service throughout the Nueces County area. The CCRTA will not provide services to areas where there is large debris on streets, where power lines are down, or to areas that are closed to the general public.

As of now the agency will continue to suspend fares for all CCRTA services through Wednesday, Aug. 30; fixed route, paratransit, and B-Line. We will resume collecting fares Thursday, August 31.

The CCRTA will operate reduced service from Tues., Aug. 29 through Wed., Aug. 30 on the following routes:

- Route 5s Alameda/Malls from 8:15 a.m. until 7:12 p.m.
- Route 8s Flour Bluff/Malls from 8:15 a.m. until 7:42 p.m.
- Route 12s Hillcrest Saxet/Oak Park from 8:15 a.m. until 7:36 p.m.
- Route 15s Ayers/Molina from 8:10 a.m. until 7:23 p.m.
- Route 21s Arboleda from 8:15 a.m. until 7:40 p.m.
- Route 24s Los Encinos/Kostoryz from 7:45 a.m. until 7:38 p.m.
- Route 27s Leopard from 8:13 a.m. until 7:24 p.m.
- Route 29s Staples from 8:15 a.m. until 7:45 p.m.
- Route 32s Southside/Malls from 8:00 a.m. until 6:53 p.m.
- Route 37s Westside/Gollihar from 7:50 a.m. until 7:46 p.m.
- Route 66s TAMUCC Connection from 8:45 a.m. until 7:15 p.m.
- Route 76s Harbor Bridge Shuttle from 10:20 a.m. until 7:10 p.m.
