1. What type of eye exam is in your protocol?

- Since the bulk of our employees are required to possess a Commercial Drivers License (CDL) they must undergo Department of Transportation (DOT) physicals during pre-employment and renewal of medical cards. One of the requirements under the physical is to have a vision exam. In order to pass the DOT physical the employee must meet the following requirements:

§391.41 Physical qualifications for drivers.

(10) Has distant visual acuity of at least 20/40 (Snellen) in each eye without corrective lenses or visual acuity separately corrected to 20/40 (Snellen) or better with corrective lenses, distant binocular acuity of at least 20/40 (Snellen) in both eyes with or without corrective lenses, field of vision of at least 70° in the horizontal Meridian in each eye, and the ability to recognize the colors of traffic signals and devices showing standard red, green, and amber;

- The Snellen test is acceptable since it would be able to determine if the employee is capable of meeting the above requirements.
- From time to time, we may have to send in employees for a Fit for Duty to ensure that they are still able to comply with this essential function if they are having certain vision issues.

2. What test are you referring to? What procedures are you referring to?
- Pre-employment medical examinations and evaluations for perspective employees;
 - Annual medical examinations/evaluations for certain job positions;
 - Medical examination/evaluation required for commercial driver's license (Class B license);
 - Drug and alcohol testing in accordance with Department of Transportation (DOT); drug/alcohol testing program to include pre-employment testing, monthly random, reasonable suspicion, follow-up, post-accident, fit for duty and return to work;
 - First aid treatment at the medical facility for work related injuries; follow-up visit for the purpose of observation;
 - Return to duty to include work fitness examinations/evaluations to determine an employee's physical ability to perform the duties of their position without undue hazard to employee or others;
 - Medical examinations and evaluations to determine if an employee's injury or illness is work related;

3. On medications: are you asking if Provider can write prescriptions if needed?
- Yes, exactly. Some of our employees will require prescriptions for work related injuries.

- Yes, these are some of the items that would be required for certain injuries that could possibly affect our employees.
