Texas Senator Juan “Chuy” Hinojosa Receives Texas Transit Association Award

He has made significant contributions to public transportation throughout his career, including securing nearly \$1 billion for the Corpus Christi Harbor Bridge Replacement Project and \$300 million for the Pharr Interchange Project to address traffic congestion.

Senator Hinojosa advocates strongly for public transit, and works closely with TTA on policy and funding issues of significance. He continues to help preserve, protect and advance initiatives that address service demands for those in need of medical transportation, those living in difficult to serve area, and those who are transit dependent.

Metro McAllen also received the “Outstanding Urban Transit System” award and “Rising Star” award for employee Jon Ray Bocanegra at the press conference and awards announcement.
