CCRTA Returning to Service on Friday, February 19th

CORPUS CHRISTI, Texas – Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority (CCRTA) will be returning to service, tomorrow, Friday, February 19th, pending external conditions.

Transportation will follow the reduced schedule, similar to Saturday’s schedule for many routes. **It is recommended that all riders download the TransLoc app for real-time updates on their buses and schedules before planning any trips.**

Fixed-route services will begin as early as 6:00am, with all service ending at approximately 8:00pm. B-Line Paratransit service will also be available for riders.
