CCRTA Will Continue to Require Facial Coverings Throughout Our Public Transit System

CORPUS CHRISTI, Texas – Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority (CCRTA) will continue to require facial coverings for individuals on all CCRTA buses (includes all vehicles) and while at CCRTA facilities, such as transfer stations or bus stops as mandated by the Transportation Security Administration (TSA).

The requirement will continue to apply to all riders, all employees including contract employees, guests and vendors visiting CCRTA facilities.

As a public transportation system, CCRTA must comply by the Security Directive 1582/84-21-01 issued by the Transportation Security Administration (TSA), which went into effect on February 1, 2021.
