HB 3693 Compliance

In response to House Bill 3693, the *Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority* (CCRTA) shall record in an electronic repository the amount of electricity, water or natural gas consumed for which CCRTA is responsible to pay and the aggregate costs of those utility services. CCRTA shall then report the recorded information on a publicly accessible Internet website.

Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2022

Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority purchases natural gas from the City of Corpus Christi. In Calendar Year 2022, CCRTA purchased a total of **99,501** cubic feet (MCF) of natural gas.

Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority purchases electricity from GEXA Energy. In calendar year 2022, CCRTA purchased a total of **4,822,073** kilowatt hours.

Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority purchases water from the City of Corpus Christi. In calendar year 2022, CCRTA purchased a total of **88,849 gallons** of water.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity, and water purchased by *Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority* in the calendar year 2022 is **\$1,422,839.84** (Add gas **\$1,008,249.34** and water **\$22,843.12** totals to **\$391,747.38** for electricity to get amount for this blank)
