

 - Explain the significance of the project for your organization and community.
 - 4,000 character limit
- 3) Part III Project Benefit
 - Describe and align the proposed project with Section 5310 program objectives
 - Include expected benefits and impacts, unique services provided, and project necessity
 - 4,000 character limit

- 4) Part IV Planning and Local/Regional Prioritization
 - Submission of relevant pages of the Regionally Coordinated Transportation Plan for the Coastal Bend
 - Submit Letters of Support for the project
 - Include Partnerships, if any
 - 4,000 character limit
- 5) Part V Local Financial Commitment and Project Budget
 - Local Matching Funds Mandatory for all submitted applications
 - Must identify the source of the local match and provide evidence of availability
 - Provide Project Budget

- 5) Part V Local Financial Commitment and Project Budget (cont.)
 - Provide project scalability, if applicable
 - Provide the project timeline
 - Technical, Legal, and Financial Capacity
 - > Applicants should prove their technical, legal, and financial abilities for the project.
 - > 4,000 character limit

- 6) Part VI Project Needs
 - Respond and complete only those categories for which you are requesting funds:
