CCRTA Providing “Your Ride to Vote” on November 3rd & November 7th
Ride Fare-Free on the Last Day of Early Voting and Election Day

(Corpus Christi, Texas) – Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority (CCRTA) will be offering fare-free rides on the **Last Day of Early Voting on November 3rd, and Election Day on November 7th**. No proof of voter registration or identification is required to ride free throughout service times. CCRTA offered fare-free rides for the First Day of Early Voting on October 23rd.

Riders should tell their Bus Operator that they’re going to/coming from voting to ride fare-free.

Fare-free transportation services available:

- Fixed-Routes
- B-Line Paratransit (ADA) Services
- Express/Park & Ride/FLEX
- Rural On-Demand Services (Paisano & REAL)

“Our goal is to reduce transportation and financial constraints as barriers to voting. We can be your ride to vote with fare-free rides this Friday, November 3rd for the Last Day of Early Voting, and on Tuesday, November 7th for Election Day,” said Derrick Majchszak, CCRTA CEO.
