CORPUS CHRISTI, Texas – Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority (CCRTA) will be providing free Gameday Shuttles from Corpus Christi City Hall to Buccaneer Stadium, which will host the 5A Division 1 State Semi-Final Playoff between Brownsville Veterans Memorial Early College High School and Smithson Valley High School.
